HYDRANT FLUSHING WILL OCCUR APRIL 13-24, 2009

The Hamilton Township Municipal Utilities Authority will be flushing fire hydrants throughout its water system on APRIL 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 20, 21, 22, 23 and 24 from 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM each day. Loss of water pressure and rusty water may occur. Although the water is safe to use, clothes washing and consumption should be avoided when the flushing procedure is being done in your area. Residents who live in Developments or Condominium/Apartment Complexes should contact their management office/association to find out when flushing will occur in their development. The mains are being flushed to remove accumulated materials that may have settled since our last flushing. Flushing the water system not only permits the removal of sediment from the mains, but also provides an operational check of the fire hydrants. - FLUSHING PROCEDURE WILL OCCUR BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:30 AM TO 4:30 PM ON THE DAYS LISTED. YOU MAY EXPERIENCE A LOSS IN PRESSURE AND RUSTY-COLORED WATER DURING THE FLUSHING PROCEDURE IN YOUR AREA. IF DISCOLORING OCCURS, RUN WATER UNTIL IT CLEARS.
- WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK. HOWEVER, IF IT IS DISCOLORED DURING FLUSHING, IT SHOULD NOT BE USED FOR DRINKING UNTIL IT RUNS CLEAR. THE WATER MAINS ARE BEING FLUSHED TO REMOVE ACCUMULATED DISSOLVED MATERIALS THAT MAY HAVE SETTLED SINCE OUR LAST HYDRANT FLUSHING.
- CLOTHES WASHING SHOULD BE AVOIDED WHEN THE FLUSHING PROCEDURE IS OCCURRING IN YOUR AREA.
- RESIDENTS WHO LIVE IN DEVELOPMENTS OR CONDOMINIUM/APARTMENT COMPLEXES SHOULD CHECK WITH THEIR MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION TO FIND OUT WHEN FLUSHING WILL OCCUR IN THEIR DEVELOPMENT.
- FLUSHING THE WATER SYSTEM NOT ONLY PERMITS THE REMOVAL OF SEDIMENT FROM THE MAINS, BUT ALSO ENABLES AN OPERATIONAL CHECK OF THE FIRE HYDRANTS.
